Visit the beach and create a piece of art or sculpture using the natural materials you find. It could be a sandcastle or a mermaid picture—what ever you like!



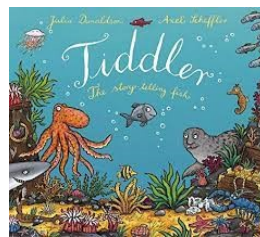
## Deep under the sea
