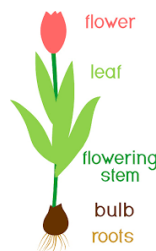
Spring Walk

There are lots of songs about springtime and Easter! Can you tell us your favourite song? Perhaps you can record you singing or dancing and put it on tapestry!



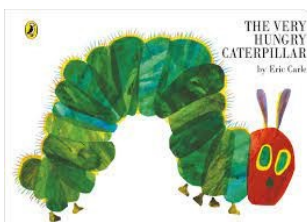
Minibeasts!
